Key Contributor Award

The Key Contributor award is presented quarterly to individuals who have made significant contributions in advancing the work in The Green Grid's various committees, work groups and task forces towards their established goals. The contributions may be in various forms: incremental work over an extended period of time or a single contribution of obvious merit. The award is limited to active participants in the committees, work groups and task forces from the various member companies.

Application Procedure

It is to your advantage to follow the template as a means of increasing understanding of the nominee's application. Provide concrete examples of work and achievement. Assume the Board of Directors does not know your specific group's details or issues, so be thorough in giving examples or definitions in some cases.
